

2016 Wrap Up

Dressage Competitions

2016 marked the end of an era, and the start of a new one for DVCTA Dressage Competitions. DVCTA has a proud history of bringing dressage competition to the Delaware Valley. In 1975 DVCTA helped to found Dressage at Devon, now a weeklong international festival of dressage including a destination Breed Show and a CDI-3* with \$35,000 in prize money. DVCTA also put on a series of accessible schooling shows each year, offering affordable, accessible opportunities to trot down the centerline at all levels, as well as a licensed show in early summer each year.

Recognized Shows DVCTA put on a successful, and full, one-day/one-ring licensed show at Dunmovin Farm on June 5, 2016, with the able work of Committee Chair Carol Lippa and manager Doreen Guthrie, as well as dozens of volunteers, providing a delightful day of competition for all concerned. Sally O'Connor judged. Classes from Intro thru Grand Prix were offered, including Musical Free Style classes. The weather cooperated, riders all seemed happy, and the TD's report to the Federation was excellent. During the noon break the 1st Level Quadrille performed their toetapping "Uptown Funk" ride. Financials were close to neutral (which is our goal). The show will go on in 2017, renamed the "Summer Opener", and will be at Dunmovin on June 3, 2017, judged by Heather Mason. As alwayswe'll need volunteers to make it happen, so please mark your calendars and come out and help!

DVCTA also continued to support Dressage at Devon in 2016 with impressive DVCTA volunteer presence, including manning the popular Pub (thank you Lisa Knox, Jr. Team Moms and Dads, and other volunteers!), as well as crowd-pleasing patriotic themed exhibition rides from our renowned 2nd Level Quad Squad!

Schooling Shows The DVCTA Board of Directors chose to make a change to our schooling show activities in 2016. Since the days when DVCTA introduced dressage to the area, accessible opportunities to show have grown each year. Given the number of high-quality schooling shows put on almost every month of the year, as well as the challenges of staffing a halfdozen schooling shows each year, we chose to move to a system of DVCTA Approved shows. DVCTA members can both earn scores towards DVCTA Year-End Awards and earn their volunteer hours helping at approved shows - a win-win for all concerned. This program was a big success in year one with shows at Dunmovin, Blue Goose, Second Nature and Straightforward Dressage all DVCTA Approved. The results are clear in the many happy award winners honored tonight. Approved shows, as well as qualifications for show approval, can be found at the Association's newly revamped website at www.DVCTA.org.

Harvest Fest was DVCTA's largest schooling championship show in recent years. Held at Blue Goose Farm, riders qualified by earning qualifying scores in DVCTA Approved Schooling Shows during the year. There were PILES of awesome prizes thanks to the sponsorship efforts led by Monica Fiss and Eliza Herman and supported by others. There were about 90 rides and the day was officiated by Kem Barbosa and Rebecca Cord. We ran two dressage rings and a third jumping ring. The day got high marks from all participants and we look forward to repeating in 2017. The only challenge was some difficulty in getting the volunteers necessary to make a large show a success. Please be ready to help in 2017.





Combined Training Competitions

We started the year with an ambitious plan for Horse Trials, Derbies and combined tests, but due to low entries we wound up having only one competition – a combined test/just dressage/just jump schooling show hosted at Boyd and Silva Martin's Windurra USA. With a full day of competition the event was a success for the competitors and the club. Our long-time Carousel Park cross-country course now has limited accessibility due to construction of new park facilities, so DVCTA is assessing alternate locations for 2017 events, including relocating our obstacles to a new facility. Education

ContinuingEducationinFreestyleClinic- On March 19 and 20th,2016, theDelawareValleyCombinedTraining

Association (DVCTA) hosted the USDF Continuing Education in Freestyle Judging Program. Saturday was filled with a classroom discussion held at New Bolton Center, and Sunday was comprised of live freestyle rides at Ardara Sporthorses. Presenters were Klassic Kur Freestyle Designer Terry Ciotti Gallo and FEI 4* and USEF "S" Judge Lois Yukins. The audience consisted of 12 Participants, made up of L-graduates and USEFlicensed Dressage Judges, approximately 25 auditors and 11 demonstration riders. This was a new event for DVCTA, and in fact a new format for USDF continuing education, and was tremendously well-received by participants and auditors. We needed a few more participants to break even, but the difference was made up by DVCTA's Marilyn Heath Judges Education fund, a great example of DVCTA fulfilling their mission to provide education in our sport.

Sponsored Clinics At the start of the year DVCTA sponsored a Lauren Annett clinic as well as two Jean-Luc Cornille Clinics. However, clinic participation by DVCTA members was observed to be quite low. As with many other areas, independent clinics in the area are now plentiful, and DVCTA support of numerous clinics does not appear to be necessary to support dressage and combined training education. The cost to the Club of

providing insurance and accounting services was exceeding the value to members, so the DVCTA Board has committed to instead focusing on one or two unique, high-quality educational opportunities per year such as the freestyle clinc, judges' forums, adult camp, or perhaps a "headliner" instructor clinic. Stay tuned for more about plans in 2017.

Scholarships Another way DVCTA supports dressage and combined training is with Scholarships. Each year we fund a number of \$100 scholarships towards a member attending a clinic. The only "payback" is sharing the knowledge gained through a report to the membership. These reports are great because they are from people just like YOU learning and sharing their insights into becoming better riders.

We had 5 Scholarship Recipients for 2016: Megan Mendenhall, Aneesa Romans, Elsie Kellerman, Sara Gartland, and Karen Clark Rubin.
