COMMITTEE REPORTS

The silent auction portion of the annual meeting brought in \$2,060 net with \$4,395 coming in from the dinner itself. The dinner cost the club \$5,721.23 and \$1,451.76 was spent on awards that were presented that evening. The club is currently sitting at \$3,600 in the red from 2017. The big picture issue is we are losing money as a club and we need to create ways to combat this; either through increased membership, increased sponsorship or an increase in the cost of membership itself.

CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW: DARCY MILLER

Harvestfest will be held October 27, 2018. The board will be creating a committee in the coming months to ensure the show runs as smoothly as possible.

Final check sent for the jumps acquired from Carousel Park. Erin is putting together ideas on how we can re-connect with the eventing community.

NEW BUSINESS

The Leslie King fund will continue through 2018.

New board members will need to research and decide on a committee they feel they could contribute the most to. They will begin their reporting in March.

New ideas for 2018:

- Adding sponsors to the website for advertisement
- Bring in new and different clinics or clinicians to increase club awareness
- Create new or highlight existing member perks to drive membership

A lively and exhilarating discussion was had about the decrease in membership and the increase of the club debt. With the addition of fresh board members the hope is that we will be able to create new ways to drive membership numbers and therefore have a larger pool of members for volunteers to come and support new and different programs we hope to offer in the future.
