SPECIAL CLASSES

Dressage Seat Equitation: A group class open to all riders. Judged on the rider's seat, position, use of aids at the walk, trot and canter. The judge may ask for movements and paces required at First level.

Suitable to become a Dressage Horse - A group class open to horses 7 years and under. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter and general impression.

Western Dressage Equitation: A group class open to all judged on the riders hands, seat, aids, performance of the horse and rider and their partnership.

Western Dressage Equitation Pattern Intro & Basic: Open to all. Riders will ride the specified pattern as specified in the USEF Rule book. To be judged on hands, seat, performance of the horse and rider and their partnership.

Pony Club / 4H - These classes are open ONLY to current members of a USPC or 4H club. These are Test of Choice classes at their respective levels. Any current test with in the level can be used. Please note on entry form the name of the USPC /4H to which you are a current member.

OTTB Dressage: These classes are open Only to horses who are Off The Track Thoroughbreds. The horse must have a Jockey Club Tattoo number. Please list the horses JC name on entry form. These classes are Test of choice at their respective levels. Any current test with in that level can be used.

Quadrille / Pas de Deux: DVCTA is known for its extensive Quadrille activities. Competitive teams are encouraged to dance their way up centerline. Quadrille can be performed with or with out music. There are standard tests available at <https://preview.usdf.org/education/other-programs/quadrille/index.asp> or create your own and add music. Qualifications are two scores of 65% or better from any approved DVCTA schooling show or licensed

RULES

Medical Armbands Required

Stadium will not be timed

Whips allowed in Dressage

Dressage tests may NOT be read except Puddle Jumper.

Combined Training will ride only ONCE, but are eligible to receive Championship ribbons since the classes may be combined.

ATTIRE

Saddlery & Attire: as per USEF rules for each discipline. USEF rules apply to Dressage, Combined Tests and Western Dressage.

Approved ASTM/SEI helmets with chin straps are REQUIRED to be worn at all times while mounted by everyone including Western Dressage

Medical Armbands: Combined Training riders must have a Medical Armband to compete. The medical information must be complete. *Please present your arm band when checking in at the secretary stand.*

Equipment Check will be performed according to USEF rules for the discipline after each dressage test; permissible bits, whip length, and other tack and equipment will be checked. *Note: Western Dressage rides will be asked to drop their bridles for the equipment check.*

Arenas & Warm Up:

Hand walking on outside of competition arenas permitted prior to start of show.

Combined Training: Arena 2: Small arena (20 x 40) on grass. Dressage & Western Dressage: Arena 1: Sand and rubber. USDF Intro & Western Dressage Intro & Basic MAY be held in small area if entries warrant. All other tests will be in a large (20 x 60) arena. Warm Up: Sand and Screenings - 90' x 180' Un Fenced arena. Jumping - on sand and screenings, 165' x 235' arena.

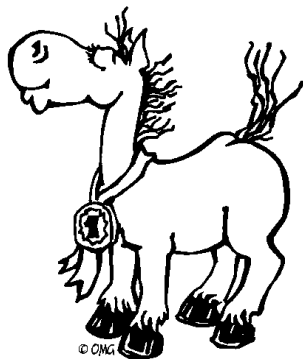
